

## **Proverbs 1:10 My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not.**

### **Sunday- What Does This Mean?**

**Focus:** Sometimes people try to pressure us to do wrong.

**Teaching Point:** “Entice” means someone is trying to persuade or tempt us into doing something we know is wrong.

**Activity:** Ask your child: “What does it mean to pressure someone?” Have them give one example of someone encouraging a **good choice** and one example of someone encouraging a **bad choice**.

### **Monday- Following The Crowd**

**Focus:** Doing what’s right even if others don’t.

**Teaching Point:** Just because others are doing something doesn’t mean we should join them. God wants us to choose what is right.

**Activity:** Say different scenarios (friends teasing someone, taking something that isn’t theirs, etc.). Ask your child: “**Follow or walk away?**”

### **Tuesday- Learning To Say No**

**Focus:** God gives us strength to refuse wrong.

**Teaching Point:** Sometimes the best answer is a simple “No.” We don’t have to explain ourselves to choose what’s right.

**Activity:** Practice saying “No, that’s not right.” Let your child role-play saying no to different situations.

### **Wednesday- Choosing Good Friends**

**Focus:** Friends can influence our decisions.

**Teaching Point:** Good friends help us do what is right. The wrong “friends” can pressure us into sin.

**Activity:** Draw two circles labeled “Good Influence” and “Bad Influence.” Let your child sort different behaviors into the correct circle.

### **Thursday-Thinking Before You Choose**

**Focus:** Wise choices protect us.

**Teaching Point:** When someone tries to entice us, we should stop and think before we act.

**Activity:** Teach a simple “**STOP & THINK**” rule:

1)Stop

2)Think: Is this right?

3)Choose what honors God.

Practice with a few pretend scenarios.

### **Friday- Standing Firm**

**Focus:** God is pleased when we refuse evil.

**Teaching Point:** Saying no to sin shows strength and wisdom.

**Scripture Memorization:** Have the child recite the scripture from heart.
