# James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

## **Sunday-Hear AND Do**

Focus: God wants us to do what His Word says.

**Teaching Point:** Listening to the Bible is good, but it's not enough—we must apply it.

**Activity Idea:** Show a recipe card. Ask: "If we only *read* the recipe but never *make* the food, will we

eat?" Compare it to God's Word—we must do what it says.

#### **Monday- What Happens If We Don't Do?**

**Focus:** If we hear but don't do, we're only pretending.

**Teaching point:** The Bible says if we hear God's Word but don't obey, we deceive ourselves—we think we're following God, but we're not.

**Activity Idea:** Play "Simon Says." Pause at the end and ask: "What if we only *heard* the words but didn't *do* the actions?"

#### **Tuesday- Jesus Teaches Obedience**

**Focus:** Jesus wants us to act on His words.

**Teaching point:** In Matthew 7:24–27, Jesus said the wise man built his house on the rock by *hearing AND doing* His words. The foolish man only heard.

**Activity Idea:** Build two little "houses"—one on a pillow (sand), one on a book (rock). Blow on them with a fan or shake them. Which one stands?

# Wednesday-Examples of Doing God's Word

Focus: God's Word tells us how to live.

**Teaching point:** Doing God's Word means forgiving, showing kindness, telling the truth, helping others, and obeying parents.

**Activity Idea:** Make a "Doers of the Word" poster. Write or draw real-life examples of obeying God this week.

# **Thursday- Practice Being a Doer**

**Focus:** I can practice obeying God every day.

**Teaching point:** Each day brings chances to do God's Word—through choices, words, and actions. **Activity Idea:** Role-play situations (Someone drops books  $\rightarrow$  help them. Someone is mean  $\rightarrow$  forgive them. Parents give instructions  $\rightarrow$  obey). Talk about how each choice shows being a doer.

## **Friday- Application**

**Teaching point:** How can you apply this verse in your life?

**Focus:** When we practice what God says, we grow stronger in faith and show His love to others.

**Scripture Memorization:** Have the child recite the scripture from heart
