

2 Peter 2:8 For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds.

Sunday- What Does This Mean?

Focus: God wants us to recognize right from wrong.

Teaching Point: Lot lived around people who were doing wicked things, but he knew those actions were wrong. God wants us to know the difference between good and evil.

Activity: Read the verse then give examples of actions (helping, lying, sharing, stealing, encouraging, teasing). Have your child sort them into two categories: Right and Wrong

Monday- Just Because Everyone Does It Doesn't Make It Right

Focus: We should not follow the crowd.

Teaching Point: Sometimes many people may be doing the wrong thing. God wants us to choose righteousness, even when we stand alone.

Activity: Play "**Follow or Don't Follow.**" Give scenarios and ask: "Would you follow the crowd?" "Or would you choose God's way?"

Tuesday- Protecting Our Hearts

Focus: What we watch and listen to affects us.

Teaching Point: Lot was troubled by the wickedness around him. We should be careful about the things we allow into our minds and hearts.

Activity: Draw a heart on paper. Inside the heart write or draw things that help us stay close to God (kindness, prayer, truth, Scripture, obedience).

Wednesday-Speaking Up For What Is Right

Focus: We can stand up for righteousness.

Teaching Point: When we see something wrong, we do not have to join in. Sometimes doing the right thing means kindly speaking up or refusing to participate.

Activity: Practice simple responses: "That's not right." "I don't want to do that." "Let's do something else." Have your child role-play using these responses.

Thursday-Choosing Good Influences

Focus: The people around us affect our choices.

Teaching Point: Friends can encourage us to do good or bad. Wise children choose friends who help them follow God.

Activity: Make two columns: Helps Me Follow God. Pulls Me Away From God

- Read different behaviors and have your child place them in the correct column.

Friday- Being a Light

Focus: God wants us to shine wherever we are.

Teaching Point: Even though Lot lived among wicked people, he knew their actions were wrong. We can be examples of kindness, honesty, and obedience wherever we go.

Activity: Turn off the lights and use a flashlight. Explain how one light stands out in the darkness. Talk about ways your child can be a light this week through their actions and words.
